Researchers in Australia wanted to find out how people spent their free time. The researchers asked people to write down all of the activities they had done for two days. The research does not include people from other countries, or Australians who live abroad. Both men and women took part in this research and answered the questions.

The results of the survey are rather interesting. Most Australians say they have from four to five hours of free time each day during the week. On weekends, people have more free time. They have between six and seven hours of free time. The researchers also compared the free time available to men and women. The results show that men have a little more free time than women. This is probably because some women are housewives and they spend more time doing housework and taking care of children.

The results of the research also show what people do during their free time. 88 percent of the people taking the survey spend time watching TV or videos. 75 percent say they enjoy time socializing with family or friends. 48 percent spend time reading. Only 27 percent say they do sport or exercise. The results also show that people often do more than one free-time activity at the same time. For example, many people enjoy socializing but they also mention watching TV at the same time.

- A. An architect is a person who knows the art of planning, designing and constructing buildings. In many countries you first need to study a lot and hard to become an architect. You must know quite a lot of subjects well to start constructing buildings that do not fall! Then you must get a licence. An architect is a profession that is famous and prestigious like doctors and lawyers. There is even the Pritzker Prize, the main award an architect can receive.

Dostoyevsky Memorial Apartment in Moscow

Fyodor Dostoyevsky's Memorial Apartment is the only museum in Moscow and the first in the world. Fyodor Mikhailovich spent the first fifteen years of his life here. The museum occupies a wing of Mariinskaya hospital. Although Fyodor was born in the opposite wing of the building in 1821, he lived with his parents in the apartment which is now the museum. There is a memorial plaque on the building.

The museum holds authentic memorial furniture pieces of the Dostoyevsky's family, portraits of his parents and relatives as well as books. In fact, the Dostoyevsky family enjoyed reading. The readings uniting the whole family usually took place in the living room. Books were taken out of the book case, the family members sat at the round table and read works by Karamzin, Derzhavin, Zhukovsky, Zagoskin and other authors.
