The World Languages

There are over one hundred and ninety countries in the world and about seven thousand languages. Chinese is in the first place. There are over one billion speakers of Mandarin Chinese. India with speakers of Hindi is in the second place. And Spanish is in the third place. Spain isn't a big country, but there are over four hundred million Spanish speakers in different countries around the world. This is very true in Latin America.

As a first language, English is in the fourth place. About three hundred and eighty million people are native English speakers. But English is in the first place as a second language for many other people. Over a billion people speak English for doing business, reading the news or studying science and medicine.

Chinese, Hindi, Spanish and English are the 'big' languages. About eighty per cent of the world's population speak them. But these are only four languages, so what about the other 6,996 languages? Many countries have lots of different languages. For example, on the islands of Vanuatu in the South Pacific Ocean there are sixty-five different islands and they have one hundred and nine different languages. However, the official languages of Vanuatu are Bislama, English and French. Bislama is a new language, made during the last two or three hundred years by mixing English with some French and some local words.

Born on November 30, 1835, in Florida, Missouri, Samuel L. Clemens worked under the pen name Mark Twain and wrote several novels, including two major classics of American literature, "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer" and "The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn". He was also a riverboat pilot, journalist, lecturer, entrepreneur and inventor. Twain died on April 21, 1910, in Redding, Connecticut. Samuel Langhorne Clemens was born in the village of Florida, Missouri He was the sixth child of John and Jane Clemens. When he was 4 years old, the Clemens clan moved to nearby Hannibal, a lively town of 1,000 people. John Clemens worked as a storekeeper, lawyer, judge and land speculator, dreaming of wealth but never achieving it, sometimes finding it hard to feed his family. He was an unsmiling fellow. According to one legend, young Sam never saw him laugh. His mother by contrast, was a fun-loving, tenderhearted homemaker who spent many winter nights with her family telling stories. She became head of the household in 1847 when John died unexpectedly. Hannibal inspired several of Mark Twain's fictional places, including St. Petersburg in Tom Sawyer and Huckleberry Finn. These imaginary river towns are complex places: sunlit and cheerful on the one hand, but also brutal nests of cruelty, poverty, loneliness, and life-crushing boredom. All of that had been a part of Sam Clemens' boyhood experience. Sam kept up his schooling until he was about 12 years old, when – with his father's death and needing to earn his keep – he found employment as an apprentice printer at the Hannibal Courier, and at 15, he got a job as a printer and occasional writer and editor at the Hannibal Western Union, a little newspaper.
