Young children whose parents read aloud to them have better language and literacy skills when they go to school, according to a review published in the Archives of Disease in Childhood.

Children who have been read aloud to are also more likely to develop a love of reading, which is more important than language and literacy. And the advantages they gain continue compared with the children who start out as poor readers in their first year of school and are likely to remain so.

In addition, describing pictures in the book, explaining the meaning of the story and encouraging the child to talk about what was read to them and to ask questions can improve their understanding of the world and their social skills.

The authors of the review explain that the style of reading has more impact on children's early language and literacy development than the frequency of reading aloud. Middle-class parents tend to use a more interactive style, making connections to the child's own experience or real world, explaining new words and

the motivations of the characters, while working-class parents tend to focus more on labelling and describing pictures. These differences in reading styles can impact on children's development of language and literacy-related skills.

Unusual Places on the Earth

Some people think that they have travelled everywhere on the Earth and have learnt about every place on our planet. But there are still some places we do not know much about. You will hear about five of them.

The Black Hole of Andros is on an island in the Bahamas in the Atlantic Ocean. The hole is 47 metres deep, and the water is 36°C and might reach even 40°C. Besides, the water is very black, it is dangerous for people to swim in it.

Mount Dinpernalason is east of the Himalayan mountains. It's 6,135 metres high so it isn't the highest mountain (Mount Everest is 8,848 metres) but nobody has ever climbed it.

Lake Vostok in Antarctica is 25 million years old and 14,000 square kilometres. It is the biggest of the seventy lakes in Antarctica. Unfortunately, you can't see the lakes because they are frozen under the ice.

The Merume Mountains are at the end of the Mazaruni River in Guyana. The journey by boat is not safe because of dangerous animals such as the largest water snake, anaconda.

The Foja Mountains in Papua New Guinea are 8,100 square kilometres of tropical forest. Nobody has ever made a map of the region.
